Why are we failing to make disciples?

3 The Problem

- 1. We forget who God says we are.
- 2. We're complacent in our salvation.
- We don't love our neighbors.
- 4. We fear opposition and rejection.
- 5. We're too busy.
- 6. We lack training and role models.

4 2 Peter 1:12-13

¹² Therefore, I will always remind you about these things—even though you already know them and are standing firm in the truth you have been taught. ¹³ And it is only right that I should keep on reminding you as long as I live.

The gospel is not just "Jesus saves" or "Jesus loves you." It's not just the first four books of the NT, either. It's the whole picture. We need to be reminded of the truth of the gospel...

5 The Solution

- 1. Be reminded of the truth of the gospel:
 - a. God is the beginning and end of all things, including creation;
 - b. God is love and light, holiness and peace, truth and comfort, justice and wrath;
 - c. The jewel of God's creation humans rejected Him because of pride, dooming themselves to a world of sin and destruction and, ultimately, death, hell, and eternal separation from God;

6 The Solution

- 1. Be reminded of the truth of the gospel:
 - d. There is nothing fallen humans can do to get back into fellowship with God we are sinful and He is holy;
 - e. God, in His great love for us, continually pursues us to be in relationship with Him;
 - f. To purchase our souls back from sin and hell, God became human, in the form of Jesus Christ, to pay the penalty for sin on our behalf;

7 The Solution

- 1. Be reminded of the truth of the gospel:
 - g. Jesus was God in the flesh born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, embodied grace and truth, and fulfilled all the prophecies about Himself;
 - h. Jesus willingly gave Himself up to be tried and convicted of false crimes and to be tortured, crucified, and killed in horrific fashion;
 - i. Jesus rose from the dead, visited with his disciples and hundreds of eye witnesses, and ascended to heaven where he lives and reigns;

8 The Solution

- 1. Be reminded of the truth of the gospel:
 - j. We can be rescued from God's judgment and restored to relationship with Him by believing that Jesus is the way, accepting the gift of salvation that only he can provide through his grace, and surrendering our lives to his lordship;
 - k. When we trust Christ and surrender to Him, God's Holy Spirit lives in us and provides us the power and freedom to do God's will, instead of living in sin;

9 The Solution

- 1. Be reminded of the truth of the gospel:
 - Jesus will return to earth for his church, which consists of all the people who surrendered their lives to Him, both dead and alive, and will take them to live with God for eternity; and
 - m. Eternal life with God is perfection, without sin and pain and suffering.

That's the gospel!

10 The Solution

2. Be reminded of what's at stake:

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (Romans 3:23)
And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment, so also Christ was offered once for all time as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. (Hebrews

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

11 The Solution

3. Love, read, and study the Bible and let it transform your mind.

12 **Romans 12:30**

And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, <u>all your mind</u>, and all your strength.

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

- 1. What is the origin of life?
- 2. What is my purpose?
- 3. What does the future hold?

The Bible answers them ALL.

18 The Tools

The Bible contains the oldest written historical record, and its claims related to human history are observable, testable, and accurate. The writers of the Bible were eye witnesses living at the time of other eye witnesses. They witnessed supernatural events that fulfilled specific prophecies. Most importantly, the writers profess that their writings are inspired by The God who proved his unconditional, impartial love at the cross.

The unique message of the Bible sets it apart from other religious texts. The Bible teaches that mankind is inherently evil and deserving of eternal death. If man were responsible for the content of the Bible, the view of humanity would not be so dark. We tend to make ourselves look good. The Bible also teaches that humans can do nothing of themselves to fix themselves. This goes against human pride, too.

The Bible was written over a period of about 2,500 years, with at least 40 human writers, most of whom did not know each other and were from varying backgrounds. And despite covering controversial subjects, it carries one harmonious message.

You should not believe the Bible just because it says it should be believed. But if the claims of the Bible are found true whenever they are proven during historical and scientific discovery, then the internal claims of the Bible are more compelling.

Many people say science and the Bible are incompatible. They aren't. The Big Bang theory and macro-evolution (all life originates from a single organism in a chemical soup) are incompatible with the Bible. And science.

Scientific method requires observation, experimentation, and repeatable results. The theory of evolution is religious. It requires blind faith.

And Jesus' life? Hundreds of witnesses and they all same the same thing – he lived, he worked

miracles, he was crucified and died on a Friday, and he walked out of the grave on a Sunday. But more than that, Jesus' life fulfilled 300 messianic prophecies. If just one or two of those had been fulfilled, it would be astounding.

And then those witnesses? They changed the world in three languages across three continents and maintained their stories through persecution, torture, imprisonment, and execution.

- 4. Live a life that's a reflection of Christ, in accordance with his word.
- 5. Pray.
- 6. Go.

25 The Tools

- 1. Pray for opportunity, wisdom, and ears to hear.
- 2. Ask a lot of questions.
- 3. Listen twice as much as you talk.
- 4. Invest time and be patient.
- 5. Don't be afraid to admit when you don't know something.
- 6. Remember that spiritual conversion is God's job, not yours.
